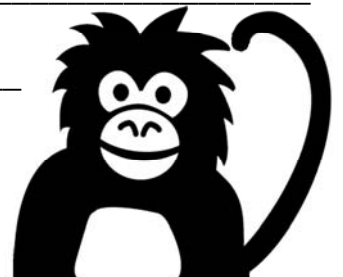

Animal that sheds its skin-- snake

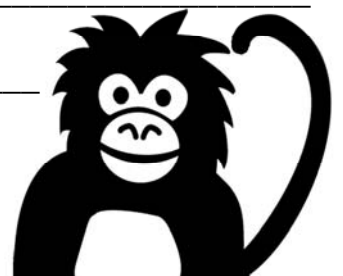
Animal that has a tail for swimming-- salamander, turtle
