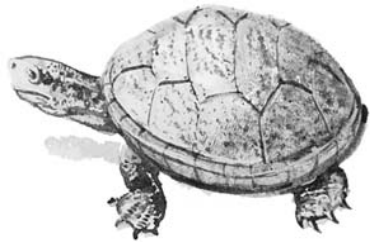


Forest Wildlife Checklist
